RULES AND GENERAL TERMS

1. Definitions

1.1. These Terms and Conditions use the following definitions:

- **Event, Race** - an event organized by the Race Organizer.
- **Race participants** - individuals (citizens of Ukraine, foreign nationals) of the appropriate age, physically able to overcome the chosen course of the Race.
- **Race Organizer** - a properly registered legal entity that organizes and conducts the Race.
- **Rules** - these Rules and General Terms that define conditions for participation in the Race. The rules act as an agreement between the Race Organizer and the participant regarding the specific event for which the participant registered. Registration for participation in the event in the order determined by the Race Organizer acts as participant's acceptance of these Rules and general terms in full.
- **Registration (entry) fee** - the participant's fee participation in the Race; its amount depends on the course and the payment period specified in the respective Race Regulations.
- **Start/finish area** - the area in front of the start/finish line. Access to the start/finish area is only granted to participants, Race Organizers, and service staff.
- **Official start** - the moment when an individual participant or several participants that start together are given the command to start. The Race Organizers determine the official start time.
- **Closing of start area** - the time after which the Race participant is not allowed into the start area and the course. The Race Organizer determines the closing time of the start area.
- **Closing of finish area** - the time after which the result of the participant who came to the finish line does not count. The Race Organizer determines the closing time of the finish area.
- **Official Time** - the time from the moment an individual participant or several participants who start together are given the command to start until the Race participant crosses the finish line.
- **Net time** - the time from the moment when the participant crosses the start line till the moment the participant crosses the finish line.
- **Unsportsmanlike conduct** - willful violation of the law, these Rules, Race Regulations, or other acts or actions of a participant considered by the panel of judges as those interfering with fair conduct of the Race or contrary to moral and/or ethical standards.

2. Organizer and management of the Race

2.1. NGO “Run Ukraine” serves as Race Race Organizer.

2.2. The Organizer establishes the Race Organizing Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Organizing Committee) from among its staff and engages third-party sport-specific specialists from various sports.

2.3. The Organizing Committee approves the Race Regulations and makes additions and amendments to the Regulations.

2.4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for:

- information support of participants;
- raising funds specifically to conduct the Race;
- preparation of documents and materials for the Mandate Committee;
- provision of prizes to award winners and medalists of the Race;
- provision of refereeing;
- lease of sports facilities, premises, and technical equipment required for conducting the Race;
- organization of security measures and medical oversight of the Race

The Mandate Commission shall supervise the preparation and conduct of the Race, review official protests and resolve disputes, and examine documents and make decisions about admission to the Race.

Chernitskyi D.L., the Race Director, serves as the Head of the Mandate Commission

The Mandate Commission includes

- Representative of the Organizing Committee;
- Chief Judge of the Race;
- Medical Director of the Race;
- Chief Secretary of the Race.
- Athletes Manager.

Professional athletes and specialists are invited to the commission.

3. General provisions

3.1. The Race is fully compliant with the Technical Regulations of World Athletics, Association of International Marathons and Distance Races (AIMS), Public Union of Athletics of Ukraine; the rules established by the Race Organizer;

3.2. The Race Organizer determines the date, place, program of the Race in the Race Regulations. The Organizer may change the date, location, schedule of the Race at any time if public authorities and local governments in the region of the Race impose restrictions (including, but not limited to, quarantine and/or intense anti-epidemic measures in the

territory with a significant spread of acute respiratory disease COVID-19 caused by coronavirus SARS-CoV-2), which interfere with the Race.

3.3. The Race Organizer has the right to make changes to the Race program. The Race Organizer notifies the Participants of such changes in advance (as far as possible) by e-mail provided by the Participant during registration for the Race and/or publishes an announcement on the relevant Race website.

3.4. The Race Organizer has the right, and in some exceptional situations even is obliged to postpone, fully or partially reduce, completely or temporarily interrupt, partially close or cancel the Race (before or during the Race), if it is likely that holding or continuing the Race may endanger life and health or pose a property threat. If that is the case, the Participants under no circumstances have the right to demand a refund of the paid registration fee for participation in the Race.

3.5. In case of force majeure and/or security reasons and/or any other circumstances that make it impossible to hold the Race, the Organizer has the right (and in case of official orders of public authorities and/or local governments - is required) to cancel the Race in whole or in part or, if possible, postpone the Race to other dates and times. At the same time, the Participants have no right to demand a refund of the paid registration fee for participation in the Race. The Organizer is not responsible for the participants' losses.

In such cases, the Organizer together with the Organizing Committee makes one of the following decisions:

- to cancel the Race;
- to exclude certain types of competitions or all types of competitions from the planned Event;
- to change the place, time, program of the Race;
- to reduce the number of participants per the instructions of the authorities;
- to change the format of the Race from "offline" to "online".

The Organizer shall notify the Participants of the decision (if possible) by email provided by the Participant during registration for participation in the Race and/or publish an announcement on the relevant Race website.

The term "force majeure" includes (but is not limited to): war, war-like conditions, riots, strikes, lockouts, lack of energy or raw materials, revolution, uprising, military or civil coup, terror, reactor accidents, uprisings, embargoes, epidemics, pandemics such as COVID-19, fire, hurricane or other catastrophic storms, as well as natural events such as earthquakes and landslides.

All current information about the organization and holding of the Race and any notifications of changes are published by the Organizer on the relevant Race websites. The Organizer is not responsible for non-acquaintance or untimely acquaintance with the specified information and strongly recommends the Participants to regularly follow the up-to-date information on possible changes in the conditions of the Race.

3.6. Given that the preparation for the 2022 Race season takes place during the period of "adaptive quarantine," approved by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No.1236 of December 9, 2020, according to which, depending on the epidemic situation in the region or individual administrative units of the region, the level of epidemic danger of COVID-19 spread is set to "green," "yellow," "orange" or "red," and depending on the level of epidemic danger certain quarantine restrictions are imposed, the Organizers consider three formats of the Race:

- **the region of the Race is located in the "green quarantine zone"** - the Race is held according to the approved program in compliance with anti-epidemic measures - "full race";
- **the region of the Race is located in the "yellow quarantine zone"** - the Race is held in a park area or on a small track;
- **the region of the Race is located in the "orange/red quarantine zone"** - the Race is held in the online format.

The Organizer specifies all Race peculiarities in each format in the respective Race Regulations.

3.7. By participating in the Race and signing the starter's letter (for Race participants 16 years of age or younger, the starter's letter is signed by legal representatives - parents or authorized accompanying persons: coach, teacher, etc.), the participant confirms that they have read all information about the Race provided by Race Organizer, understood and agreed to all the Rules of the Race, violation of which can lead to participant's disqualification.

3.8. The event website is the official source of information. E-mail is the official source of communication and provision of information to the participants. The organizer sends all official information to the e-mail address provided by the participant in the personal account on the runukraine.org website.

4. Refund of the entry fee

There is no refund of the money paid as an entry fee under the Public Offer Agreement, which the participant accepts upon registration for the Race.

5. Personal information

Participants are aware that all Races organized and conducted by the Organizer are public events. They can be covered in the media online on the Internet and/or social networks and offline on radio, television, and print media. Participants must understand that they can get in the photo or video in the materials covering the Race.

The organizer or the service providers involved on his behalf during the Race may take photos and videos and/or interview participants during the sporting events. The Organizer has the right to use (or not use) the images, videos, and interviews taken in any way and for any purpose without any payment from the Race Organizer and prior agreement of such use with the Participants.

Participants grant the Organizer the exclusive right, unlimited in terms of time, space, and subject matter, to reproduce, distribute and publicly display photos, videos and interviews, make them available for search, in particular for commercial use, as well as for offline and Internet advertising and advertising on social networks, including use in magazines, newsletters, posters, photo and video impressions of the event and press releases, etc.

By registering to participate in the Race, Race participants automatically confirm that they agree to their personal data, photo, video, or audio materials with their participation to be used without their consent for Race advertising without any payment for such use as by the Race Organizer as by any third parties to whom the Organizer has granted the right to use them.

Participants waive their right to be named during each (including public) use of photo, video, or audio material with their participation.

The Race Organizer can use all photos and videos of the Race available to the Race Organizer as supporting documents confirming the accuracy of the Race results and/or cases of violation of the Race rules.

Personal data provided by participants during registration will be stored and processed by the Organizer and third parties involved in the organization and conduct of the Race for the organization and conduct of sporting events, including printing/publication of race results and/or provision of medical care to the participants on the track and at the finish line by medical services in charge of the event, as well as for payment processing.

Data processing is carried out under the requirements of the legislation of Ukraine.

The Organizer also processes and publishes the last name, first name, year of birth, nationality, gender, club (if any), starting number and result (place and time) of participants to present lists of participants and results in the relevant media accompanying event (including on the Internet), and may transfer this data for publication to third parties and store it to create an archival database of results.

6. Costs of Race organizing and conducting

The Race funds are raised by attracting sponsors and partners and participants' entry fees. Given that the registration fees are part of the funds that cover the costs of the Organizer for the organization and preparation of the Race and without which the preparation and holding of the Race would be impossible, returning the paid registration fee for participation in the Race or reimbursement is impossible.

Travel, accommodation, and food costs are borne by sending organizations or the participants themselves.

7. Registration for the Race

7.1. Participants are allowed to enter the Race provided proper and timely registration for the Race.

7.2. The Race Organizer has the right to suspend or completely close registration for the Race without any prior notification.

7.3. Registration for the Race is performed online on the website of Race Organizer. The website of the Race Organizer providing registration is specified in Race regulations.

7.4. Registration for the Race is performed online by filling in the application form on the website of Race Organizer and paying the entry fee.

7.5. Registration for the Race is considered completed after the full amount of the entry fee paid by the participant is transferred to the account of the Race Organizer.

7.6. A registration is considered canceled if the entry fee is not paid within 3 working days after submission of application and not later than 3 working days before the day of the Race.

7.7. The total number of participants on all Race courses is limited and specified by the Race Organizer on the website and in the event press release.

7.8. Registration for the Race can be closed early if the total limit of participants on all courses is reached.

7.9. There is no registration on the day of the Race.

7.10. By filling in the registration application, the Race participants agree to the collection, storing, use, processing, transfer to third parties of the data provided during the registration process for marketing purposes of the Race Organizer.

7.11. By filling in the registration application, participants agree to their personal information, photo, video, or audio materials with their participation being used for advertising purposes without their consent or any compensation from the Race Organizer.

7.12. If the Race is held in the ONLINE format, the Organizer may offer a "late registration." Athletes who purchase slots under these conditions will receive their Starter Packs 21 days after the Race.

8. Entry (registration) fee

8.1. The entry fee is set by the Race Organizing Committee and has different costs. The entry fee amount depends on the payment period specified in the Race Regulations and the chosen course.

8.2. Payment of the entry fee is carried out by electronic payment on the Race Organizer's website, specified in the Race Regulations.

8.3. The entry fee does not include the money transfer fee.

8.4. Payment of the entry fee in cash is only possible during additional registration and sale of "Optimal Starter Packs" along with distribution of starter packs, which will take place the day before the event, provided that the total limit of participants on all courses has not been reached.

8.5. The entry fee paid by the participant may be transferred to another person within the event free of charge no later than 30 days before the day of the Race.

In the 30 days before the start of the Race, the service **“Entry fee transfer”** or **“Course change”** is available for a fee. The cost of the service is 250 UAH.

The participant must purchase the **“Certificate of entry fee transfer”** or **“Course change certificate”** from the online store at <http://runukraine.org/shopping>.

The participant must submit an individual application by sending a letter to registration@runukraine.org with "Entry fee transfer No.*certificate order*" or "Course change No.*certificate order*" in the subject line and the necessary data provided.

After the procedure, the new participant receives a new non-personalized Race bib number with a result capturing electronic chip and everything else provided in the starter pack for a particular course. The previous participant's Race number specified in the application is canceled.

Please, notice! There is a limited number of certificates. The service is only possible if you have this certificate.

8.6. The entry fee paid by a Race participant is non-refundable no matter the circumstances, including if a participant is unable to take part in the Race; if a participant is unable to complete the course of choice; if a participant is unable to meet the set time limit; if a participant is disqualified or the Race is canceled due to force majeure, etc.

8.7. Race participants who have paid the entry fee for a particular course may not change their registration to another event for any reason.

8.8. The Race Organizer has the right to change (reduce) the cost of the entry fee in case of failure to provide certain goods and services (T-shirts, food stamps, etc.).

8.9. The Organizer has the right to set the cost of the entry fee at his discretion and to change its amount at any time based on changes in the price of goods and services provided to the participant.

8.10. If the Race is held in the online format, the participant must pick up the starter pack from the Nova Poshta office within 5 calendar days from the date of pack arrival at the branch office. If the package is not picked up within this period, it will be returned to the Organizer. In this case, it is possible to receive the pack either from the organizer's office (Kyiv, 14/7 Pyrohovskoho Street, office 201) or have it re-shipped using a "re-shipment certificate." The certificate can be purchased from the Run Ukraine store.

9. Privileged categories

9.1. Free registration is provided for retirees (women aged 59 and men aged 60).

9.2. Reduced registration is available for other categories of citizens of Ukraine (35% discount on the basic cost of registration at the time of payment):

- internally displaced persons from the ATO area

9.3. Free registrations are available on all courses except for charity races but are limited to not more than 2 registrations per person within a calendar year:

- for combatants and war veterans. The number of free registrations is limited to no more than 30 people for the Work.Ua Kyiv Half Marathon 2022, Wizz Air Kyiv City Marathon 2022, and no more than 15 people for other events.
- people with disabilities of 1, 2, 3 groups. The number of free registrations is limited to no more than 15 people for the events within the Ukrainian Majors Running League 2022.

If the limit on the number of privileged slots is reached, a 35% discount on the basic registration applies.

9.4. One person may receive not more than 2 free registrations per calendar year.

9.5. Reduced registration for students:

- there is a 35% discount on the basic registration cost at the time of payment for students, regardless of the number of participants.

The participant must submit an individual application by sending a letter to registration@runukraine.org with "Special category" in the subject line.

When submitting your application, please, include supporting documents according to your privileged category: copy of your passport, pensioner's ID, combatant ID, pension ID of a person with a disability, special ID card of the internally displaced person from the ATO area.

If it is found out that a participant wrongfully claimed a privileged category at registration, such registration is canceled without any compensation from the Race Organizer.

YOU CAN GET YOUR FREE OR DISCOUNTED STARTER PACK ONLY UPON PRESENTATION OF THE ORIGINAL COPY OF YOUR VETERAN ID, ID OF A PERSON WITH DISABILITY, PENSIONER'S ID, OR CERTIFICATE OF AN INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSON.

10. Participant starter packs

10.1. The number of starter packs is limited and determined by the Race Organizer.

10.2. The starter packs are sold on the Race Organizer's website, specified in the Race Regulations.

10.3. The number of starter packs may be changed by the Organizer.

11. Distribution of starter packs

11.1. The starter packs are distributed a couple of days before the date of the Race, which is specified in the Race Regulations. Starter packs may also be mailed to the participant at the address specified in the participant's personal profile.

11.2. Participants who cannot pick up their starter packs the day before the Race date must notify the Race Organizer 7 days before the Race date by email specified in the Race Regulations.

11.3. There is no distribution of starter packs on the day of the Race.

11.4. Race participants must pick up starter packs in person upon presenting the starter letter and ID document. If a participant cannot pick up the starter pack in person, a third party may do this upon presentation of all the documents specified in the Race Regulations.

11.5. A Race participant who was unable to participate in the Race may receive their starter pack within one calendar month from the day of the Race. The participant can either pick it up directly from the Race Organizers or arrange shipment of goods by mail at their own expense. After one calendar month from the day of the Race, the Organizers are not responsible for preserving the product, and they are entitled to dispose of it at any time.

12. Basic Rules of the Race

The Race is carried out in full compliance with the technical rules of athletic competitions of World Athletics, Association of International Marathons and Distance Races (AIMS), Athletics Association of Ukraine, Technical Race Regulations, Advertising Rules, and decisions of Race Organizers.

The Race Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Race Program.

12.1 Basic rules:

- The Race Organizer reserves the right to cancel the Race (before or during the event) due to weather and/or other force majeure circumstances;
- Rules and General Terms is an official document that acts as a contract between the Race Race Organizer and the participant;
- Any suggestions, amendments, and supplements to this document are accepted by email to the Race Race Organizer: registration@runukraine.org.

12.2 Health.

- Each Race participant participates in the Race voluntarily, recognizing all possible risks to their health during and after the Race;
- Each participant takes personal responsibility for their physical condition and ability to complete the chosen Race course;
- Accident insurance, which covers participation in sports competitions on the day of the Race, is included in the participant's starter pack for all courses;
- The Race Organizer is not held responsible for physical trauma, injuries, and deterioration of physical health that a participant experiences during the Race;

- The Race Organizer is not held responsible for the deterioration of the physical health of a participant after the Race.

12.3. Emergencies during the Race

TO THE ATTENTION OF ALL RACE PARTICIPANTS!

In the event State Emergency Service issued a warning of possible significant deterioration of weather conditions in the region on the eve of or on the day of the Race or there is a threat to human life and health due to severe weather phenomena (including but not limited to earthquake, flood, hurricane, hail, cyclone, storm, lightning, other natural disasters), the Race Organizer reserves the right to take measures to ensure the safety of participants, audience, fans and all those who directly or indirectly participate in the Race.

The Race Organizing Committee has developed an internal safety scale, according to which in case of severe weather phenomena, the Organizing Committee will act according to the plan and require all participants to comply with its requirements, namely:

1st level of danger - wind with a force of 7-9 meters per second - dismantling inflatable arches, light structures (including mileage indicators), light awnings, promotional and photo zones.

2nd level of danger - wind with a force of 9.5-10 meters per second - dismantling of all awnings, photo zones, as well as dismantling of the crossbar of the start-finish arch.

The project manager will ask you to remove anything that may be dangerous.

High probability of cancellation of children's races. The decision to hold or cancel them will be made immediately before the start of the children's races based on the actual weather conditions at that time.

3rd level of danger - wind with a force of 11 meters per second and more - the committee will make a collegial decision to hold or cancel the Race.

The committee in charge of this decisionmaking consists of Dmytro Chernitskyi, Director of the NGO "Run Ukraine," Ivan Tretiakov, Project Manager, a representative of the SES in the region, a representative of the title sponsor of the Race (or another official of the title sponsor of the Race).

FOLLOW THE REPORTS OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE!

13. Liability for property damage

13.1. The Race Organizer is not held responsible for any damage caused to the health and/or property of Race participants or spectators before, during, or after the Race by other Race participants, spectators, third parties, or weather conditions.

13.2. The Race Organizer is not held responsible for any damage to the health, property of Race participants, or spectators caused before, during, or after the Race by actions or inactivity of the services ensuring the order of motor traffic on the route, municipal, or other services servicing the Race.

14. The Race

14.1. Each Race participant must unconditionally follow the instructions of the Race Organizer, judges, medical staff, and volunteers until the participant is removed from the course.

14.2. Each participant is given a Race bib number that must remain visible on the chest throughout the Race.

14.3. Each Race participant must write personal information (name, contact phone number, e-mail, blood type) on the backside of the race bib number.

14.4. It is strictly forbidden to give your Race bib number to another person to use it in the Race on the course of choice.

14.5. Each Race participant must independently overcome the course of choice along the marked route, without cutting the distance, and adhere to the traffic rules of Ukraine.

14.6. Each participant bears personal responsibility for their safety while participating in the Race.

14.7. Race participants are strictly forbidden to use technical means (bicycles, motorcycles, motorbikes, etc.) on the Race courses.

14.8. Race participants are strictly forbidden to use "guidance" from persons who do not participate in the Race or "guidance" using technical means (bicycles, roller skates (in running), etc.) on the Race courses.

14.9. Race participants are not allowed to participate on two courses that start at the same time and follow the same route (half-marathon and relay race, marathon and relay race).

15. Team Races (relay 3x5+1x6,0975 km, relay 3x10 + 1x12,195 km)

Mixed teams of commercial and non-profit organizations consisting of 4 people are allowed to participate in the relay.

If the organization cannot find 4 members from within, it can invite volunteers.

All four members of the team are required to participate in the relay race.

A team is considered registered if its representative has filed an application form, filled in a registration form, and paid the team's entry fee.

Each participant is assigned a particular relay stage upon registration. The order of participants can be changed on the website runukraine.org, in the participant's personal profile.

During the relay race, the chip transfer procedure must only occur in a special "transfer zone."

After the Race, the relay teams taking places 1 through 5 must report to the judges at the

information tent to go through the identification process. The team members must have their IDs, your Race numbers, and wear bracelets received in the starter pack.

Violation of any of the above rules will result in the disqualification of the entire team.

The result of the relay team is the result of the participant of the last, fourth, stage of the relay at the finish line.

Payment for participation in a corporate relay is made by bank transfer based on the invoice issued by the Race Organizers. The proof of payment must be sent to registration@runukraine.org no later than 10 days before the event. All questions regarding the organization of the corporate relay should be forwarded to registration@runukraine.org.

16. Time limit

The time limit in athletic Races is:

- marathon (42.195 km) - 6 hours;
- half marathon (21.0975 km) - 3 hours;
- 10 km running - 1 hour 20 minutes;
- 4.2 or 5 km running - 40 minutes;
- 4.2 km walking - 45 minutes;
- 3 km running - 25 minutes;
- 2 km running - 20 minutes;
- 100 m, 400 m, 500 m, 800 m, 1000 m, 1500 m running - no time limit

Race participants who are unable to finish the Race within the time limit are taken off the course and may continue running outside the Race route (sidewalks, pedestrian lanes, etc.), adhering to the traffic rules of Ukraine.

17. Race courses and participants age limits

The Race is open to all runners of appropriate age, regardless of gender, as required by the Race Organizer:

In athletic courses:

- marathon, half marathon: individuals - participants 18 years and older;
- 10 km and relay Races - participants aged 15 and older;
- 5 km and relay Races - participants aged 14 and older;

The age of a Race participant is determined as of December 31 of the current year.

Please, notice! Participants 15-17 years old must also have Parental (legal representative) consent to the participation of a minor in the Race on the courses of 4.2 km, 10 km (Annex 1 or Annex 2, respectively)

Participants can only participate on one course, according to the Race program.

18. Result Scoring System

The scoring system is provided and ensured by:

- Electronic timekeeping system;
- Judges using manual timing devices only for the first 5 men and 5 women.

Race Organizers would like to note that the electronic timekeeping system has a certified loss percentage - no more than 3% of the total number of chips.

The Race Organizing Committee does not guarantee capturing individual results of each participant in the following cases:

- participant attached the number incorrectly;
- participant started the Race with someone else's Race bib number;
- Race bib number is torn, crumpled, etc.;
- result capturing electronic chip has been demagnetized, torn, crushed, etc.;
- Race bib number was lost.

Throughout the course, the Race bib number must be preserved in the form in which it was received. It is strictly forbidden to remove, cover and/or damage it (cut, bend, etc.).

The Race Organizer must publish a preliminary Race protocol on the event website no later than the next day after the Race.

Participants may appeal preliminary results no later than 30 minutes after the official results are published in the Information area and the area for Race judges.

The cost for submission of an appeal is 500 UAH (five hundred hryvnias).

In case of satisfaction (partial satisfaction) of the appeal, the money is returned.

Protests and appeals are not considered after this deadline.

In case the Race is held in the "online" format, a participant is required to personally capture their result using an electronic device (watch, phone, etc.) and send it to the Organizer's email at registration@gmail.com.

19. The Procedure of Determining Award Winners and Medalists

The award winners and medalists of the competition among athletes are determined according to finishing according to paragraph №165.24 (WA rules).

19.1. Each type of Race has age requirements and awards. After determining the winners on each course, the Race Organizers publish Race results on the website specified in the Race Regulations.

19.2. The prize scale is determined by the Race Organizer for each course at the discretion of the Race Organizer.

Payment of monetary prizes to the determined winners of the Race is made by non-cash transfer within 7 calendar days from completing the Race. The payment is made to the winner's bank account. The monetary prize shall be paid only when the winner provides the Race Organizer with the originals and copies of their documents: passport, personal tax code, and complete bank card details.

A participant may be awarded late if they failed to attend the award ceremony in their age group. In this case, the prize is sent by mail at the expense of the Race Organizer to the address specified by the participant at registration (only on the territory of Ukraine, foreign citizens pay money transfer fee at their own expense).

The Race Organizing Committee is not responsible for prize delivery if the participant has given an incorrect address.

Winners and medalists receive special prizes.

A participant who has been awarded in absolute championship may not be awarded in their age group.

20. Disqualification

The panel of judges reserves the right to disqualify a participant if:

- a participant ran under another participant's Race number;
- a participant used a shortcut;
- a participant ran a course for which he/she was not registered;
- a participant used means of transportation (bicycle, scooter, car, etc.);
- a participant started the Race before the official start;
- a participant received assistance during the Race from outsiders;
- a participant started the Race after the start area had been closed;
- a participant came to the finish line after the finish area had been closed;
- a participant did not start the Race from the start area;
- a participant ran without the official Race number;
- a participant used doping;
- a participant displayed unsportsmanlike conduct.

All photo and video materials available to the Race Organizer may be used by the Race Organizer as supporting evidence confirming violation of the Race rules.

21. Information sources

Detailed information about the Race is published by the Race Organizing Committee on the official website specified in the Race Regulations.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for information from other information sources.

22. Conditions for participation of children and adolescents.

A person registering a child to participate in the Race agrees that:

- the decision on the participation of their child in the All-Ukrainian mass sports event among pupils and students (hereinafter - the Race), which is held by the NGO "Run Ukraine" remotely, is VOLUNTARY and made consciously without any coercion in full capacity;
- is aware of all possible consequences for the life and health of their child while participating in the Race;
- the state of health of their child allows them to participate in the Race;
- the child is not under the influence of any medical substances;
- in the case of any medication prescribed, they had consulted a doctor in advance and received permission for the child's participation in the Race;
- understands the potential danger to the life and health of the child from the child's participation in this Race and waives any possible legal claims against the Race Organizer for any physical, property and non-property damage caused to the child;
- they know the conditions of the Race, specified in the Race Regulations.

23. Rules regarding the insurance of participants.

By signing the "Liability Waiver"* section, a participant with their own signature certifies their consent to be an insured person under the Life Insurance Contract under the "PERSONAL PROTECTION" program (hereinafter - the "Contract").

By affixing a handwritten signature in the specified document, the participant agrees to:

- collection, processing of their personal data in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Personal Data Protection" by JSC "IC "TAS"(private), including personal data relating to health and their transfer to third parties (additional notice of such transfer is not required) for the purpose of execution and maintenance of the Insurance Contract;
- the Insurer appointing the Insured Person as the Beneficiary, for all insured events, except for the "Loss of Life" cases;
- the Insurer appointing the person indicated by the participant in the above-mentioned document as the Beneficiary in the "Loss of life" case. If at the time of the insurance case all appointed Beneficiaries have died or have not been appointed by the Insured Person, the insurance payment is made to the heirs of the Insured Person in accordance with applicable law.

Also, by affixing a handwritten signature in the specified document, the participant certifies that:

- they are acquainted with and agree with the terms of the Contract, the Rules of voluntary life insurance in the version in force at the time of concluding the Contract;
- they are acquainted with their rights as a subject of personal data and received a notification on processing and inclusion of information about themselves (personal data) in the database of personal data of clients of JSC "IC "TAS" (private) for execution and maintenance of the life insurance contract
- they authorize JSC "IC "TAS" (private) to apply to third parties (doctors, medical establishments, institutions, authorities) to clarify the circumstances relevant to the implementation of the Contract, as well as authorize any doctor or medical employee who was (is) participating in their treatment to provide all necessary medical information upon request to JSC "IC "TAS" (private).
